

BYLAW NO. 01-2017

**A BYLAW TO RESTRICT THE DEPOSITING OF SNOW ON
STREET RIGHTS-OF-WAY**

**Pursuant to Section 8 of *the Municipalities Act* the Council of the Town of
Saltcoats in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:**

SECTION I – DEFINITION

1. “Street Right-of-Way” means all or any part of a road allowance, public highway, road, street thoroughfare, lane alley, walkway and sidewalk.

SECTION II – INFRACTION

1. No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited, ice or snow on any street right of way.

SECTION III – PENALTIES:

1. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bylaw or fails to comply herewith or with any notice or order given hereunder shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties as follows:
 - a) \$50.00 – First Offense
 - b) \$100.00 – Second and Subsequent Offenses
2. A person who refuses or neglects to comply with an order by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer to move snow or ice deposited on a street right-of-way, in addition to the penalties prescribed in Section III (1), shall be liable to an additional penalty of \$50.00 per day that they refuse or neglect to comply with said order.
