The next general election for urban municipalities will take place on **Wednesday, October 26, 2016**.

It is important to become involved in your community's affairs and exercise your democratic right to choose the leaders of your community.

Call for Nominations

Nominations for Councilors (6) and Mayor will be accepted at the Town Office until Wednesday, September 21, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at 117 Allan Avenue, Saltcoats, SK.

If you are interested in running for Council or Mayor, please stop by the office to pick up a Nomination Form or call the Town Office at 306-744-2212 for more information. A criminal record check that is dated no more than 30 days prior to receipt of the Nomination Form is required to be submitted along with the

Nomination Form.

Who Can Run?

Persons eligible for nomination as a candidate must:

- be at least 18 years old on Election Day;
- be a Canadian citizen;
- have resided in Saskatchewan for at least 6 (six) consecutive months immediately preceding the date on which the nomination paper is submitted;
- have resided in the municipality for at least 3 (three) consecutive months immediately preceding the date on which the nomination paper is submitted.



Advance Polls

Voting for the Advance Poll will take place on Saturday, October 22, 2016 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the Stirling Room of the Community Services Building at 117 Allan Avenue. The

Advance Poll is for electors who:

- Are physically disabled;
- Have been appointed as election officials; or
- Anticipate being unable to vote on the day of election.

Election Day

Voting for the Election Day will take place on Wednesday, October 26, 2016 between 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. in the Stirling Room of the Community Services Building at 117 Allan Avenue.


Who Can Vote?

Persons eligible for voting must:

- be at least 18 years old on Election Day;
- be a Canadian citizen;
- a resident of Saskatchewan for at least 6 (six) consecutive months immediately preceding election day;
- either: A) a resident of the municipality for at least 3 (three) consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election; or B) an owner of assessable land for at least 3 (three) consecutive months immediately preceding the day of election.

Parking of Recreation Vehicles (RV) and Trailers

Please ensure that the following regulations are followed when parking any type of RV (camper, trailer, boat, etc) or trailer within the Town of Saltcoats limits:

- Units shall only be parked on the street for a maximum period of 72 hours.
 - Parking on boulevards, in alley ways or on Town of Saltcoats property is not allowed.
 - Creating issues for regular vehicle or pedestrian traffic is not allowed.
 - Units parked in driveways shall not hang over onto the street and/ or side-walk
- These regulations are set by the Town of Saltcoats Traffic Bylaw No. 09-2007 Please refrain from parking in spaces that will obstruct views of oncoming traffic.



Utility & Tax Notice Contact Information

If your contact information has recently changed please notify the Town Office. There may be times when the office needs to contact residents regarding their water accounts and current contact information is necessary.

It is tax time again and fraudsters will use this opportunity to attempt to scam consumers and businesses out of their hard earned money. Fraudsters impersonate the real Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) by telephone or by email; they are either phishing for your identification or asking that outstanding taxes be paid by a money order service business or by pre-paid debit/credit cards.

Protect yourself:

- Do not take immediate action. Verify that what you are being told is the truth.
- Ask yourself why the CRA would be asking for personal information over the phone or email that they likely already have on file for you as a taxpayer.
- Contact the CRA to confirm that you owe back taxes, or are entitled to a refund before providing any personal or banking information.

Rabies

Rabies is one of the few diseases in Western Canada that poses a risk of being passed from your pet to you. Saskatchewan Agriculture is reminding residents that rabies is present across much of the province. Approximately 7 positive cases of rabies were reported in the month of June, in Saskatchewan. It is also important to know that **Rabies is ALWAYS fatal to your pet** but can be prevented by vaccinating your pet.
