The Town of Saltcoats would like to remind residents that as per Bylaw No. 09-2007 "The maximum speed shall be forty (40) kilometres per hour on all streets within the town limits, except as relates to the school zone(s)." Please slow down - children are out of school and playing outside.

Road Repair Update

The Town of Saltcoats Public Work's annual pothole patching has commenced and will continue to be scheduled through the remainder of the summer, provided that the weather cooperates! Excavated areas in Town will be re-surfaced once the ground has settled and the settling of the excavated site has subsided, which may take sometime depending on the size of the excavation.

The complete replacement of street surfaces in Town remains cost prohibitive based on options available at this time, however finding a workable solution is ongoing. In the mean time, sections of deteriorating surfaces that have been broken up will be dealt with on a case by case basis as available resources permit.

The sections of the streets that were repaired using the Permazyme process require further remediation to correct the surface failure issue during wet conditions. In light of two previously unsuccessful reworks performed by the original contractor, the Town has been working through legal processes to again effect repairs as soon as possible, but to also finally ensure the surface is functional in all weather conditions, and durable enough to provide appropriate longevity.

Compost Information

Pick-up will be every Saturday until October 1st.

Compost pick-up will be at the back alley, if you do not have a back alley please place compost in the front.

What is compost?

- Leaves, grass, weeds, vegetable tops (bagged in biodegradable or clear bags)
- Small branches from tree and bush trimming (bundled please)

What is NOT compost?

- Tree, hedge, and large bush removal
- Branches that cannot be safely handled by 1 person or requiring town employees to use a chainsaw to break down.

Call the Town Office for pick-up of non-compost materials, fees will apply.

2015 Annual Waterworks Financial Information

The following information regarding the operation of the Town of Saltcoats waterworks is provided as required under The Municipalities Act and Regulations.

Comparison of water & sewer revenues to expenditures including debt payments:

$(\$270,106 / (\$260,771) = 1.0358$

For 2015 water revenues covered 100% of expenditures with approximately **\$9,335** additional revenue to be added to the waterworks reserve for 2015.

Mosquito Control Tips

Mosquitoes require water to breed.

Adult mosquitoes lay eggs in stagnant or slow moving water, or on moist soil or leaf litter in areas likely to collect water. By eliminating these water sources, you can keep new generations of mosquitoes from taking up residence in your yard.



All businesses doing business in Saltcoats require a CURRENT BUSINESS LICENSE for the Town of Saltcoats. Residents can ask their contractor or the Town Office to check if they have acquired a business license. Business licenses are available at the Town Office during regular business hours. Residents are strongly encouraged to only do business with companies with a current business license issued by the Town of Saltcoats.



A new public emergency alert notification system is now active for all of Saskatchewan. Residents can opt to receive emergency alerts for the entire province, for a particular community, or for multiple communities. SaskAlert.ca will house all information on current emergencies, and is a vital resource for helping residents protect themselves. Emergency alerts may be issued for emergencies such as train derailments, tornadoes, blizzards, wildfires, hazardous material spills, boil water advisories, road closures, evacuations or local emergency declarations. Alerts are only issued for emergencies that could harm

people or damage property.

Tree Protection from Beavers

Due to recent reports of beaver activity along Anderson Lake shorelines, please be aware that there are measures property owners may take to protect trees near the water. Trees can be protected by wrapping heavy mesh hardware cloth, thin gauge sheet metal, or a few layers of chicken wire around the base of a tree to a height of one meter. Reporting beaver damage or activity on your property to the Town Office, can assist us with control measures to mitigate damages.
