

# Saltcoats Residential Curbside Recycling

## Acceptable recyclable items include:

- all plastic bottles and containers labeled with # 1-7. Examples include most containers for yogurt, milk, peanut butter, condiments, beverages, vitamins, mouthwash, shampoo, bleach and detergent. If unsure, check the recycling number on the bottom of the plastic container to make sure.
- cardboard boxes, newspaper, magazines and other paper products
- pizza boxes, if there is no grease or food left in the box
- tin, aluminum cans, bottles, containers and aluminum foil
  - milk and ice cream containers
  - black and clear plastic takeout food containers (no styrofoam please)

- Strings, ropes, wires and cables
- Medical waste
- Electronics
- Yard waste
- Toys

- Toothpaste tubes
- Food
- Multi material products such as frozen juice containers
- Hazardous waste, such as household chemicals, motor oil, antifreeze, batteries, lighters and paint cans
- Housewares including TV's, printers, computers, microwaves, radios, etc.
- Styrofoam
- Tires
- Household garbage
- Batteries of any type
- Glass of any type

## Items that will NOT be accepted:

- Any plastic items not labeled with # 1-7 including pens, straws, laundry baskets, Tupperware, etc.
- Bottle caps and lids
- Soiled cardboard
- Disposable cups for coffee, pop and Slurpees
- Organics
- Plastic plates
- Auto parts
- Oil
- Aerosol cans
- Scrap metal
