BYLAW NO. 3-2004

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SALTCOATS TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of Town of Saltcoats, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 1-2003 be repealed.
- 2. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
- 3. Sections 4 and 5 apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
- 4. Subject to the provisions of section 3, any individual found guilty on summary conviction of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of The Urban_Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$250 and not more than \$2,000, and costs for every offence.
- 5. Subject to the provisions of section 3, any corporation found guilty on summary conviction of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, <u>The Urban Municipality Act</u>, shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$250 and not more than \$5,000, and costs for every offence.
