### Saltcoats Historic Cemetery News

Launched in 2022, the Cemetery Rejuvenation Project set a fundraising goal of \$40,500 and is now just \$818 away from reaching it - an incredible milestone for our community.

As part of the project, ten area maps have been purchased and will be installed this spring throughout the cemetery. Each map offers an opportunity for memorial or remembrance dedication, creating a lasting tribute to loved ones.
