Upcoming By-Election

By-election for one councillor member was set for May 13, 2026. Watch for nomination day notices.

Pet licenses are due January 31. Fees for cats and dogs are as follows:

- Male and female pets - \$25
- Spayed and neutered pets - \$10
- Proof of vaccination against rabies within 2 years of the date of application is required for licenses to be issued.

Business licences are due for 2026. Fees for business licences are as follows:

- Owner of a commercial property in the Town of Saltcoats - **No Charge**
- Resident or ratepayer in the Town of Saltcoats - **\$40.00**
- Resident or ratepayer in the R.M. of Saltcoats or other rural municipality but having a Saltcoats mailing address - **\$40.00**
- Any other person or business - **\$60.00**



Important Reminders:
