Dog Owners

There has been fecal matter left by owners from their dogs that is accumulating on and around our streets and entrances to town owned facilities where others walk and play. Please pick up after your pet.

Dogs must be **leashed at all times** when not confined to your property even if it is late at night or very early in the morning. There will be no exception to owners who insist on walking their dogs leash free.

The school yard, skating rink, curling rink and Legion Park are **NOT** off leash areas. Dogs must be leashed and cleaned up after - children are at play in these areas.

Bylaw 03-2022 lists the penalties that will be enforced onto dog owners. This bylaw is available on the town website.

Pet licenses are due for 2024.

Fees for cats and dogs are as follows:



Male and female pets - \$25 Spayed and neutered pets - \$10

Proof of vaccination against rabies within 2 years of the date of application is required for licences to be issued.

Business licences are due for 2024. Fees for business licences are as follows:

- Owner of a commercial property in the Town of Saltcoats -
- Resident or ratepayer in the Town of Saltcoats \$40.00
- Resident or ratepayer in the R.M. of Saltcoats or other rural municipality but having a Saltcoats mailing address -\$40.00
- Any other person or business \$60.00
