Call For Food Concession Operator Tenders 2026 Regional Park Season

Tenders are now being accepted for the Food Concession Operator for the 2026 summer season at the Saltcoats District Regional Park.

The successful tender will be responsible for the following:

- All costs associated with stocking and operating the concession building.
- All revenues derived from the retail sales are retained by the operator.
- Provide defined hours of operation for the season. **Commitment to defined hours is absolute.** Daily hours will be given preference.
- May be required to collect Park Pass fees within the Regional Park.
- Have a safe food handling course (Food Safe) or the ability to obtain certification.
- Annual Rent of \$1,200.00 for the season.
- Terms of the tender will be effective May 15th, 2026 to September 7th, 2026 (inclusive). (could be extended if weather permits and both parties are agreeable)

All tenders will be considered, however only the successful tender will be guaranteed a response. For more information, contact:
