COMMUNITY REMINDERS

Residential Utility Rate Increase—Effect July 2025

Starting July 2025, new rates for water, sewer, waste, and recycling services will take effect. Residents can expect slight increases on quarterly bills.

Rates will be as followed:

- Water: \$219.00 (up \$10.95)
- Sewer: \$81.00 (up \$4.05)
- Waste: \$39.00 (up \$3.00)
- Recycle: \$21.00 (up \$3.00)

Increase from \$339.00 to \$360.00



SaskEnergy Pipeline Inspection—July to October

SaskEnergy inspectors will be in the area between July and October 2025 to conduct routine inspections of the natural gas pipeline system in Saltcoats. This is part of their regular maintenance and safety program.

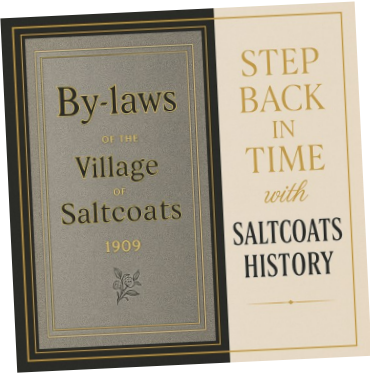
