## PUBLIC NOTICE

As per the Water Security Agency and Sask Health Legislation, it is illegal to make any connection between the Potable Water Utility lines and any other water source.

The fear of such a situation is the possibility of the other water source contaminating the town's potable water.

Non-compliance with these regulations may result in a boil water advisory and/or the removal of the affected property from the utility system.

### Property Tax Notices

2023 property tax notices were mailed out on April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2023.  
Due date: June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023

- A charge of 1.5% will be applied on the first day of each succeeding month on any taxes remaining unpaid after June 30<sup>th</sup>.

- Failure to receive a tax notice does not relieve the ratepayer from payment of taxes nor from liability of penalty/interest for late payment.
