Saltcoats District Regional Park Authority

The Saltcoats District Regional Park Authority was established in 1962. The original founding members of the Park Authority were the RM of Saltcoats, the RM of Wallace, the Town of Saltcoats and the Town of Bredenbury. The current membership consists of the RM of Saltcoats and the Town of Saltcoats. The SDRP Board is made up of 7 members. The members are Dennis Hunt (Chair), Stephen Farquharson (Vice Chair), Shirley Pearson (2nd Vice Chair), Jesse Baron (Town Rep.), Chad Waloschuk (Town Rep.), Robert Morgan (RM Rep.), Karen Hovind (RM Rep.), and Town of Saltcoats CAO Cindy Larson as the treasurer (non-voting). The land is owned by the Town of Saltcoats and leased by the Park Authority. The Park Authority operates under its own constitution. Both the RM of Saltcoats and the Town of Saltcoats make annual financial contributions to the Park Authority. The Park Authority also applies for grants when they become available. The SDRP Board is always grateful for any and all donations, whether it be volunteering or financial. In 2021, groundskeeping equipment was replaced, the Park welcome sign was replaced and grounds clean up and painting were done. Capital plans for the next five years include dock repairs and replacement, establishing a better water supply, electrical upgrades for Garstone and Oliver campgrounds, upgrades to Oliver washrooms/showers and a major project to clean up the Lake and beach area. In 2022, we will again be asking for tenders for the concession and for groundskeeping. If you or someone you know is interested, please contact the Town Office for more information. The SDRP Board is always looking for new ideas for the Park so please share any you might have. The Park is an asset to the community and the SDRP Board is very proud of all it has to offer. It is there for everyone's enjoyment and people are encouraged to plan their own activities as well as take part in all activities and amenities it has. The more it is used, the better for all. Looking forward to another fun year!
