Attention children of all ages! Enter to win a pool from the Town of Saltcoats!

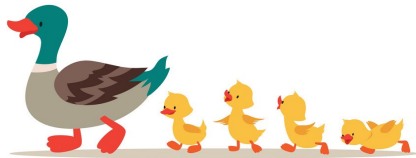
