1. Your mailing address. Please inform the Town Office if any updates to your address are required.
2. Your utility account number.
3. Your billing period. Utility billing cycles are completed every three months (quarterly). Bills are due at the end of the period.
4. Your water consumption. Water consumption is measured in gallons. Your usage is the amount of gallons consumed in the previous quarter. You will have either an A or an E in front of your usage amount. The A means an actual reading was done and the E means an estimated reading was done.
5. Amount charged for water consumption. Residential properties are given 9000 gallons of water per quarter at a flat rate of \$197.10. After the first 9000 gallons have been consumed, a charge of \$0.0095 per gallon is applied. Overages are applied to the next quarters utility bill.
6. Total of the flat rate plus any overages from the previous quarter.
7. Your sewer, recycling and waste fees are each charged at a flat rate.
8. Total of all current fees charged for this quarter.
9. Total due includes the total charges as well as any unpaid balances or credits carried forward from previous billing periods. A 2% interest is charged per quarter on all overdue accounts.

School Bus Safety

School is back in session and that means school buses are back on the road. We have received complaints of motorists passing buses while the red flashing lights are activated and children are loading/unloading.

When approaching a bus that has its red flashing lights activated, motorists must stop no closer than 5 meters (15ft) from the front or back of the bus. You may only proceed once the red flashing lights have stopped. Before moving, check to see that all children have safely crossed the roadway.

Passing a school bus with red flashing lights is a serious offence and motorists will be reported to the RCMP.
